Staffed with Brandeis law students and supervised by a licensed attorney who is an adjunct professor at the Brandeis School of Law, we can help prepare simple wills, living wills, and power of attorney and healthcare surrogate documents.

\*to be eligible, your income can be no more than 2.5 times the federal poverty level.
