CRIT | Clinical Retreat for Interdisciplinary Training In Geriatrics and Palliative Care

The University of Louisville Trager Institute is excited to be hosting the 6th Annual CRIT program, a single-day immersive experience that increases the knowledge and clinical skills of professionals serving older adults.



Although CRIT is a virtual event this year, the interactive and engaging nature of the program will be a mainstay. In reinforcing the importance of interdisciplinary collaboration in caring for older adults, this year's program will provide learners a variety of learning opportunities, including case study, lectures from experts, an action project, and networking opportunities.



WHAT TO EXPECT

This immersive and engaging retreat program is centered around a case that is divided into four modules aligned with the 4Ms of Age-Friendly Health Systems (What Matters, Medication, Mentation, Mobility). Participants work through the modules in interprofessional groups. Each module includes evidence-based mini-lectures on topics in geriatrics and palliative care, interactive exercises and team-building activities, and presentations designed to enhance clinical skills.
